Now entering its eighth year, Namatan reaches over 4 000 people around the country. Thanks to our partner, Vanuatu Broadcasting and Television Corporation (VBTC) and our sponsors Digicel Vanuatu, ANZ Bank and Air Vanuatu, we are introducing a **new school category** this year 2019 willnto be bigger and better.

The name 'Namatan' (or 'eye') and slogan 'ae blo yu, lukluk blo mi' were chosen to represent the festival. Namatan's aim is for ni-Vanuatu filmmakers, amateur and professional, to share their vision and for the audience to take their own messages away from each story.

2019 UNIQUE ITEM

A condition of entry in the Namatan Short Film Festival is that all films <u>must</u> include the designated 'unique item'. This is to prove that the films created are specifically for this year's festival. The 2019 Unique item is a **Vanuatu traditional woven basket**. A woven basket was chosen to symbolise the ban of plastic bags in Vanuatu and to promote the conversation and use of traditional handicraft to support the local economy.
