Vanuatu

- Vanuatu has led the way, and our bid to co-host COP31 with the Pacific will elevate the region’s interests internationally—and will be an opportunity for Vanuatu to maintain and strengthen its leadership on climate action.
- Australia shares Vanuatu’s concerns about the need for urgent action to address the climate crisis
- The unanimous support for this resolution shows there is a shared responsibility for all States to act on climate change.
- Australia **recognises the need to transition away from fossil fuels**, and we recognise that a global net-zero transition requires the use of fossil fuels to be phased down. We are taking real and significant climate action at home and have committed to
 - setting a target to have a world leading 82 per cent renewables share in the National Electricity Market by 2030;
 - enshrining our 2030 and 2050 emissions reduction targets into law, providing the strongest possible signal to investors and industry of our commitment to decarbonise Australia’s economy;
 - reforming the Safeguard Mechanism, putting over 200 of Australia’s biggest emitting industrial facilities on a clear pathway to net zero by 2050; and

- committing \$23.5 billion of investment in the latest Budget to climate and energy initiatives, to accelerate the modernisation of Australia's electricity grid and take meaningful action on climate change
