## Torba road upgrade gets underway

The Minister for Infrastructure and Public Utilities, Jay Ngwele, and Australia's High Commissioner, H.E. Sarah deZoeten, were in Torba Province this week to celebrate the start of an exciting new road project.

The project will upgrade 3.74 kilometres of Vanua Lava's core road network connecting Sola's airport to the school, hospital, market, and the provincial headquarters. Importantly, the road's new surface will reduce travel time and connect businesses and communities in the largest population centre of the province.

The VUV250 million works, supported by the Australian Government, will make roads safer, require minimal maintenance, have improved drainage and a surface that will provide all-weather access to withstand severe weather events.
